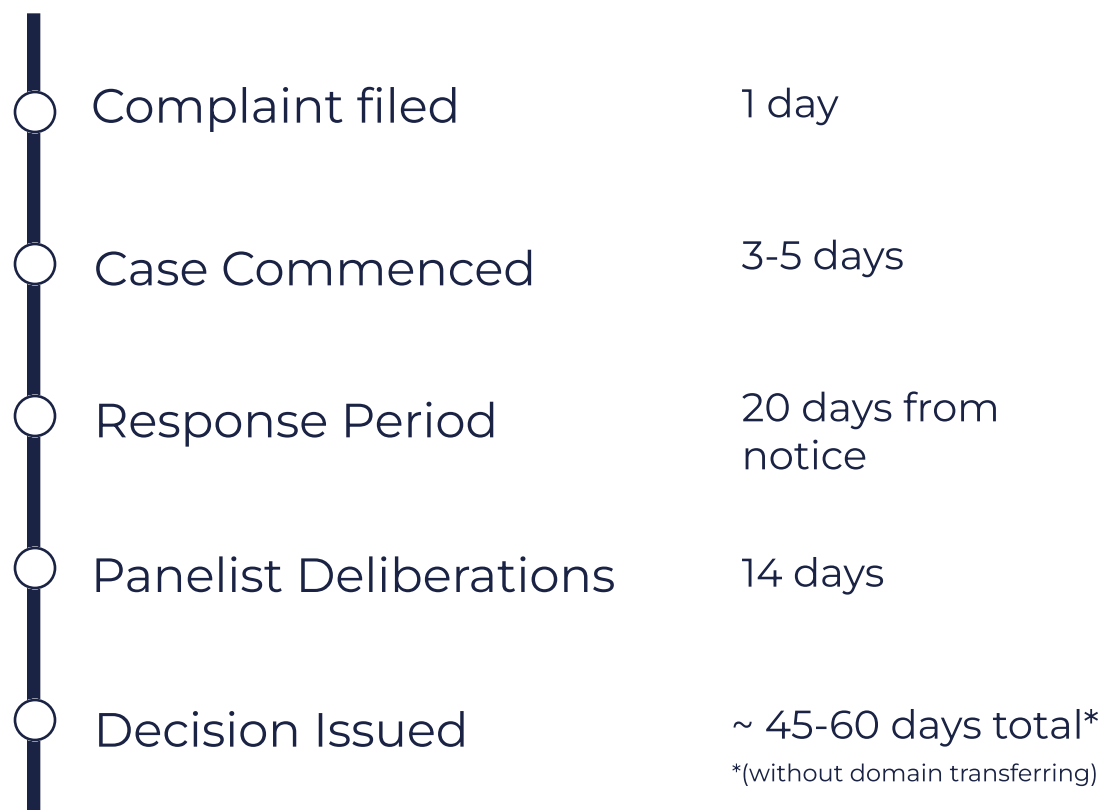

What is UDRP proceeding and when can it be used?

UDRP proceeding is an out-of-court procedure that allows trademark owners to combat the abusive registration and use of domain names that incorporate their trademarks.

Which domain names fall under the scope of UDRP?

UDRP applies to generic top-level domains (gTLDs), such as .com, .net, .org, .net and certain country-code domains (ccTLDs) that have adopted the policy, such as .cy, .cc, .pk.

How long does the UDRP case take?

On average, UDRP case takes between 1 to 2 months from the complaint filing to the actual domain transfer.

How much does UDRP procedure cost?

On average, UDRP case takes between 1 to 2 months from the complaint filing to the actual domain transfer.

How long does the UDRP case take?

On average, UDRP case takes between 1 to 2 months from the complaint filing to the issuance of a decision.

What decisions can be rendered?

- Cancellation of Domain Registration
- Domain Transfer
- Complaint Denial

! Note that monetary damages cannot be claimed under UDRP and financial losses can only be recovered through national courts.

What happens if the UDRP complaint is denied?

The domain stays with its current registrant. The trademark owner can still pursue the matter through national courts, which are not bound by the UDRP decision and may award damages.

How much does UDRP procedure cost?

The filing fees vary depending on the dispute resolution service provider. However, on average, they range from 800 to 2,000 USD for a proceeding handled by a single panelist.

Is legal assistance required for UDRP case?

No, legal representation isn't required for a UDRP case. However, since the UDRP process involves complex legal issues and requires well-supported arguments, proceeding without legal expertise can significantly reduce the chances of success.

Is it possible to file a UDRP complaint against multiple domain names?

Yes, a UDRP complaint can include multiple domain names (consolidation), as long as they are registered by the same person/entity or there are evidences of common control.
