Introduction

Corporate Law and Investments

We helped a client on a turnkey basis — from legal entity registration to launch readiness — to establish a company and operational infrastructure for a major international conference.

An investor risked losing real influence until the share was formally registered. We structured the deal so that the investor gained control and protection of interests even before conversion into a stake.

A shared construction agreement for a multifunctional center brought together land law, construction law, and investor protection mechanisms in a single transaction.

An option agreement in the real sector of the economy allowed the client to lock in deal terms in advance without taking on immediate obligations.

The client needed not the counterparty's assurances, but an objective picture. We conducted due diligence on the adequacy of collateral — and the client made their decision based on verified facts.



Debt Collection and Work with Debtors

4 CASES IN THE LAST TWO WEEKS

A client faced a bank account freeze. We secured its unblocking through appeals to government authorities — without a single court hearing.

Before initiating costly enforcement proceedings, we verified the debtor's assets. The client received a realistic assessment of collection prospects and was able to make an informed decision on further strategy.

The debtor company had been formally liquidated, but that was no obstacle to recovery: we helped bring the beneficiary to subsidiary liability and collect the debt.

The collection of accounts receivable was accompanied by the freezing of the respondent's accounts — the interim measures eliminated the risk of asset stripping before the proceedings concluded.

Regulatory Compliance

1 TASK OVER THE PAST TWO WEEKS

New trade restrictions threatened to halt the client's supply chain. Instead of pausing business operations, we developed a clear action plan for navigating the evolving regulatory environment.

Intellectual Property and Brand Protection

2 TASKS OVER THE PAST TWO WEEKS

Domains, typosquatting, UDRP disputes — we helped shut down multiple channels of unauthorized use of the client's brand simultaneously.

A competitor challenged the client's trademark. We resolved the dispute through a pre-litigation demand process, avoiding court proceedings entirely and saving the client both time and legal costs.

Regulatory Advisory by Industry

4 TASKS OVER THE LAST TWO WEEKS

A legal opinion on the regulation of educational activities gave the client clarity before making an important operational decision.

We prepared a regulatory opinion for a major online platform. The risk assessment allowed them to adjust processes before any regulatory claims arose.

We analyzed pharmacovigilance requirements across six jurisdictions. Instead of separate country-by-country research, the client received a unified picture of regulatory requirements.

When switching medical software vendors, we determined in advance whether re-registration of the product would be required. The client factored this into structuring the contractual arrangements, ensuring continuity of supply.
